PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

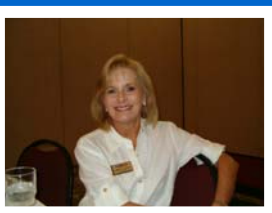
For Isn't it great to be a Sertoman? Isn't it great to know we have a 56 year tradition of kindness and good deeds here in Columbia?
